



## **HCSA General Secretary Election 2017 Authorised Declaration Form**

Regulation 6 of the HCSA rules state that any member can be nominated to stand for the post of HCSA General Secretary by receiving at least 40 nominations from full members of which no more than 10 must be in a single HCSA geographical constituency. In addition the HCSA Executive Committee shall have the right to nominate a candidate for election as General Secretary. Such a candidate may or may not be a member of the HCSA.

Nomination forms must be accompanied by a completed authorised declaration from the nominated candidate stating that they accept the nomination and agree to serve under the terms and conditions if elected.

If more than one valid nomination is received there will be a postal ballot of members. A postal ballot for HCSA General Secretary will be conducted amongst all eligible HCSA members. The HCSA General Secretary will be elected for a five-year term of office.
